If you're looking for a detailed review of the E100 Glow, you can check out the product reviews in the article. What is the Razor E100? The Razor E100 is an electric scooter, battery powered. It's a kick-start model, i.e. the engine starts to power the scooter to give it some stimulation before the kick. It is a child-sized model with a small frame and deck for children about 8 years old. This does not mean that young children can't use it, all on the contrary! This is a great scooter for young kids too, as you can learn in a few sections ahead. The important thing to consider is the size and weight of the child who uses it, the ability to perform basic physical exercises to control the scooter. I ride wonderfully smooth, the electric motor is very quiet. It has a convenient twist grip throttle and handbrake. What is the difference between E100/E125/E150/E175? Put it simple, all these different models are the same as one. I spend a fair time studying the differences, and I can't find any, except for their colors. And this is not always standard. If you look at the official Razor E100 manual, you can't find any difference. In addition, all parts are the same as those stated in the manual. So when I couldn't find anything explicit about each model on the official website or product manual, I decided to go directly and contact customer service. To be honest, I thought this could be a lost cause, and I thought I wouldn't get an answer in time for this post. Surprisingly, razor customer service replied to me in a matter of hours. This is a text response I got from Razor: Hello Martin, E100/E125/E150/E175 Electric Scooter Family is all a kickstart model and is designed for ages 8 and older - with a children's size deck and frame. Eco-friendly electric power, which travels at speeds of up to 10 miles per hour, involves very quiet chain-driven motors. All of these models run the same. Other models are based on the retailers that are sold. We appreciate your interest in our products and let us know if we can give you additional information. Seriously, RazorSo has nothing more to add. Razor officially confirms that all of these models are the same in functionality. The only caveat I can add is that you can Store them in different color options depending on... But besides that, there are differences in how they run or their main functions. Can my toddler drive a razor E100? As we already mentioned at the beginning of the article, this is a children's scooter. It is intended for children 8 years and older, but young children can ride safely. As a parent or adult in charge, you should use some common sense and know if your child can handle the scooter appropriately. In other words, pay attention to how your child controls the weight of the scooter and how much control it controls through it at different speeds. The maximum speed of the E100 scooter family is 10 mph or 16 km/h. This is a fairly low speed that young child riders can easily control. All adults in good shape can easily run to their side if needed, or can easily catch up with them using a bike. There is no age maximum limit to riding the E100, but it should be taken into account that there is a maximum weight limit at 120 lbs or 54.4 kg. So this will limit what children should use it. The scooter works under heavy loads, but we do not recommend it for an extended period of time. We know that there are several parents who have tried themselves on their child's scooter, putting about 150 pounds or 68 kg. on a scooter. The Razor E100 continued to work at almost full speed and had no problems. This will let you know that the scooter is sturdy, and don't rest by having a heavy child on it. But we recommend that you play by the rules and keep an eye on the maximum weight. If you really want an electric scooter for heavy kids, you can only go with the Razor E200 or Razor E300, that is basically the same type of electric scooter, but with a little more power and higher weight limits. Made available by any older child and adult. How long does the Razor E100 battery last Amazon.com get a great price for the Razor E100? The Razor E100 is powered by two 12V lead acid, sealed and rechargeable batteries to create a 24V battery system. On a flat surface, the scooter can be used continuously for about 40 minutes. You can definitely ride through a slight slope, but keep in mind that this speed will also affect power consumption, reduce autonomy time and require faster charging. To keep the battery at its best, you must follow the rules outlined in the owner's manual. Just keep in mind: you'll be charged an initial fee of 12 hours. The charging time can be up to 12 hours. Charge your battery immediately after riding. Fully charge the battery before storing for a long time. When not in use, remove the charger from the wall outlet. If the battery is not charged periodically, the battery may not be allowed to charge. Make sure the scooter power switch is turned off when the device is not in use. If the power switch is turned on for a long time, the battery may reach a stage where it no longer holds the charge.via How difficult is it to assemble the dot-com razor E100? Assembling the Razor E100 is easy, but it's good for adults. It takes about 10 minutes for assembly and some tools help: 5mm Allen wrench (not included) 3mm Allen wrench (not included) 8mm open wrench (not included) 10mm open wrench (not included) 13mm open wrench (not included) 16mm open wrench (not included) 16mm open wrench (not included) Philips screw (not included) If you have a pressure gauge (not included) for schrader-type valve tires, do not despair if you do not have all these tools. We saw comments and customer reviews that mentioned that the assembly was easy and everything we needed was provided in the box. So we assume that they mean that Allen Wrench did the trick and you can run away with an open wrench that is too simple. Keep this in mind as the battery needs an initial charge of 12 hours. The initial assembly will be fairly fast, but you will have to wait a few hours before you can ride it. Plan ahead so your kids don't go crazy around you for 12 hours! During the research phase for this article, I also bought this scooter family and invested some time reading through a lot of Amazon customer reviews, while high torque, chain-driven motorwrist grip acceleration control hand operation front brake8 pneumatic front tire (20.32cm) urethane rear wheel rental kick stand. I try to summarize my research in a way that gives you a clear idea of what experience your customers have, what good and bad via razor dot com has about 1,000 customer reviews on Amazon at the moment you write. About 85% of them were very satisfied and happy customers offered their products in 4 and 5 stars. For this satisfactory group, the most common remarks were easy assembly, robustness, and in many cases they noted that the product was operating on the first day even after daily use 1, 2 and 3 years. The battery had to be replaced several times over the years, but for most customers, it was good and even expected, as most customers said they could not expect the battery to last forever. There were also some good advice and comments that can help you, and can even be synchronized with your case. For example: Overly protected parents recommend scooters. He always felt safe despite the tendency to protect the child and said it was really easy to run in terms of a speeding scooter or speeding scooter. Back to the bike if you don't exercise. One customer said the scooter battery was constant and used quickly. But this is expected and after getting a replacement battery (really affordable price), you can keep having fun. The only thing I can continue to use for two years is to change the battery! For other owners it was worth mentioning how easy it was to set up. And after the initial charge was ready to go. A common problem for those people: the product didn't work at all in the first place. In all cases, the store's customer support was sent out with care and a replacement soon. In one case, the front tire shattered and had to be replaced. It also applies to warranty. And in some cases there was a problem with the battery, cable wiring. But as I've already mentioned, all 15% of the reviews had these problems, but there were only a few. In all cases it is worth mentioning that the problem was covered by warranty and that the customer received a replacement. What is the verdict on the Razor E100? The following is my personal opinion, and we recommend that you evaluate and produce your own verdict based on all the research we have presented in this review. All in all, I will undoubtedly go this scooter. 85% of reviews are incredibly good coming from owners who have scooters for more than 2 years in most cases used daily! Really annoying and bad reviews are not a big deal for me, I returned the original product and contacted customer support and was fixed with all the warranty and replacement.
